The competitor guarantees that every person who has taken part in the production of the submittet work, agrees with the participation. The contributor guarantees furthermore, that no third person's or parties' rights are violated through the presentation and/or the submission of the work, and that the organizer of the exhibition

cannot be sued for any violation regarding these rights. G.A.S = S[alion] is allowed to make a copy resp. a DVD of the submitted video works for presentation purposes during the exhibition and for archiving. Finally, the contributer guarantees, that she/he is authorized to submit the contribution for admission in the exhibition free of charge, and that she/he has the rights for the work.
